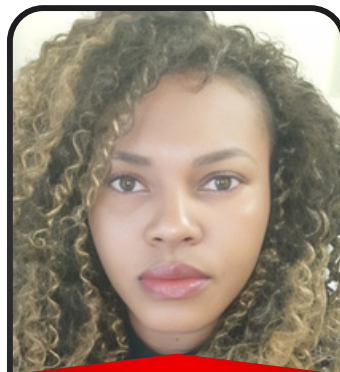

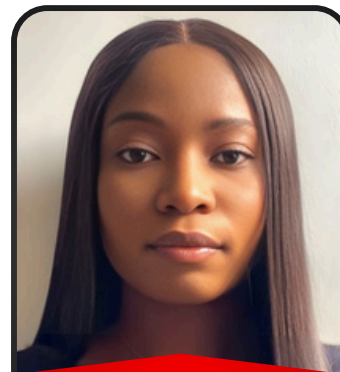

## Fela Bank-Olemoh

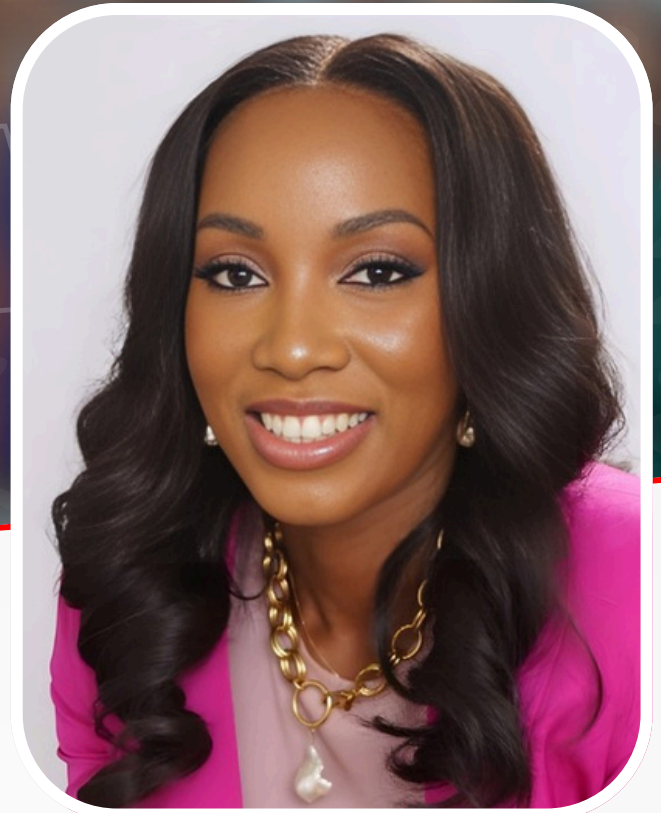

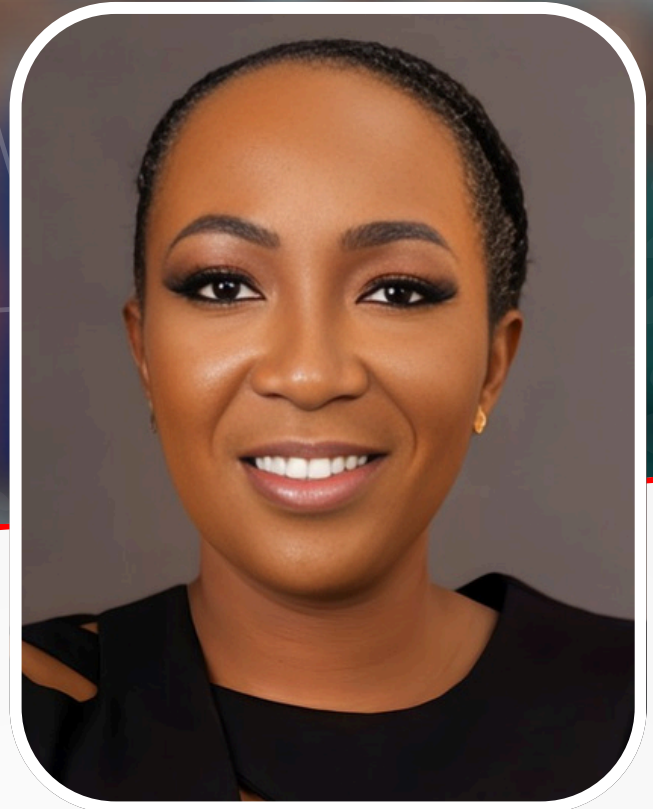
